The issue: 696 million people still lack safe water at home. In both Zambia and Mozambique, 42% and 48%, respectively, still lack access to safe water in rural areas, and more lacks even basic sanitation facilities. Yet here in the UK, we often take water for granted, whether it's boiling the kettle for a cuppa or washing up after a slice of cake. Without safe water, there would be no tea time!

The solution: Village Water works with district, provincial and national partners in Zambia & Mozambique, and supports lasting, local solutions to reach everyone with water, sanitation and hygiene, leaving no one behind.

The Goal: Raise funds for Village Water by organising an afternoon tea to support communities in rural Zambia and Mozambique with safe water, sanitation, and hygiene education (WASH).

How you can help: Every sip and every slice shared at a Tea & Taps event helps bring safe water, sanitation, and hygiene to communities that need it most.



Hosting your own Tea & Taps is simple, fun, and makes a real difference! Here's how to get started:

Step 1 – Pick a Date and Venue: Choose a day to host your afternoon tea, at home, in your garden, at work, or even online!

Step 2 – Invite Your Guests: Ask friends, family, or colleagues to join you for a cuppa and some treats.

Step 3 – Brew, Bake and Set Up: Put the kettle on, bake or buy your favourite cakes, and decorate your space with a tea-time theme.

Step 4 – Raise Funds: Encourage everyone who attends to donate £5 (the cost of a coffee or slice of cake) to help Village Water bring safe water, sanitation, and hygiene to communities in Zambia and Mozambique.

Step 5 – Share the Moment: Take photos, share your event on social media, and tag #TeaAndTaps to spread the word. We love seeing teacups, mugs, and glasses being raised for Tea & Taps events!

Step 6 – Send in Your Funds: After your event, simply send your donations to Village Water via bank transfer. Please get in touch with us to receive our bank details and instructions.
